- The two-state room, one-head layout is spacious and warm with ample windows and hatches providing light.
- Forward berth is a "V" berth with filler, custom foam mattress, hanging locker, and under berth storage.
- Aft stateroom has a large twin berth, hanging locker, and drawer storage,
- Manual flush head with shower forward (never used).
- The salon area is light and airy with overhead hatches, dual windows above port and starboard, teak and holly sole, LED lighting, and a varnished wood interior.
